North Cascades Corvairs needs your support as members to continue, as well as to participate in the activities.

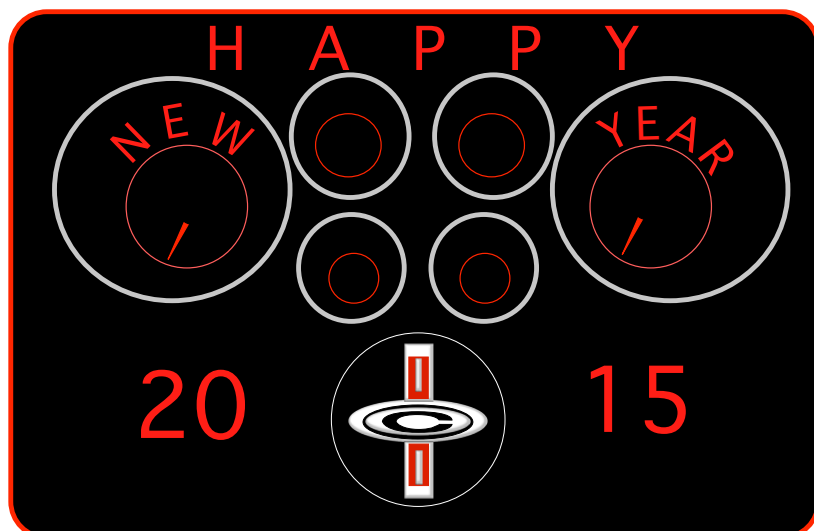

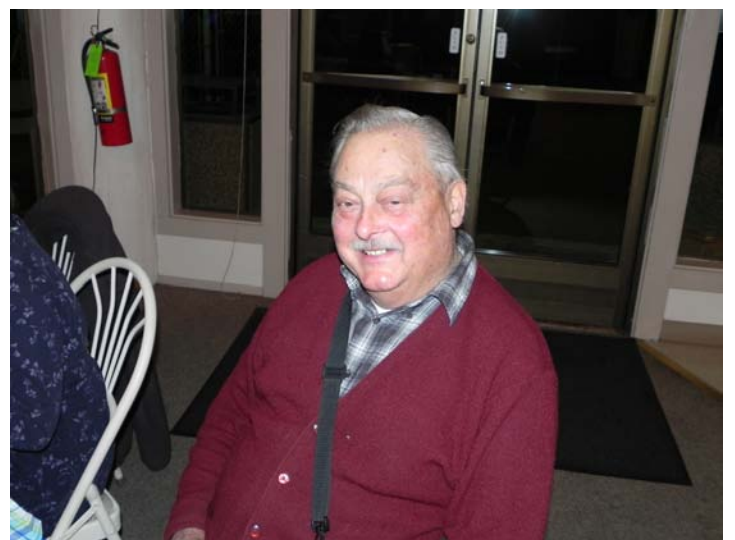

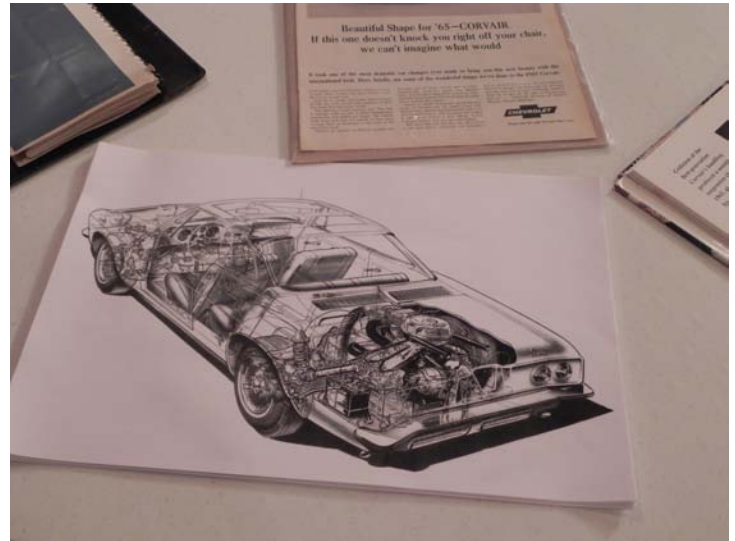
