Or we could have both, and meet at the South end.



The poster above tells the story. North Cascades Corvairs will be the host club for the Pacific Northwest Corvair Econorun in 2012, and it will be held in La Conner on the first weekend of May. This design shows the twin peaks of the North Cascades that show up in our club logo, the roadway through the Skagit Valley indicating the Econorun Rally, and of course, a Corvair.

This should show up on all information about the event, and may even be printed on T-shirts if there is enough interest. More details on the next page.

Pacific Northwest Corvair Econorun

We will use both of La Conner Lodge's facilities for the host hotels. The Channel Lodge is on the waterfront, and two blocks from the Country Inn. The Channel Lodge has 40 rooms available, most with a water view. The Country Inn has 28 rooms available.

The room rates for us, for all non-water view types, would be \$129 plus tax (regularly \$169-\$229), and includes a continental breakfast of homemade granola, fresh pastries, fresh fruit, hard boiled eggs, hot chocolate, gourmet coffees and teas. They have agreed to put all of these room on hold for us for our dates, and will hold them until 45 days before our potential use.

They have several meeting spaces that can handle 18 people, or up to 75 people, depending on what we need, with no additional charge. We can use these for our reception and registration, and/or casual meetings.

There is a banquet room above the La Conner Seafood and Prime Rib House that is available for up to 100 people, that would be free when they provide the food service, and they can build a menu around our budget. If we need more space, it may have to be extended downstairs in their regular restaurant.

Our use of the Marina Parking lot for the car show has to go through the Commissioners, and our information has been submitted. This will probably be free.

There is a new Chevron gas station on the west side of the bridge, run by the Swinomish tribe, that can probably be used to fill our tanks for the Econorun.

The course for the Econorun will be determined by a volunteer that steps forward, but will probably traverse several scenic points of Skagit, and/or Island County. We continue to work with the La Conner Chamber of Commerce, and it appears we will have coupons with discounts at about 60 establishments in La Conner.

We need volunteers to help with the many functions to make this a great event. Let us know if you are ready to help, and we will find something to suit you.
